Mokelumne Fire District Firefighter Employment Opportunity: The Mokelumne Fire District is now accepting applications for the position of Seasonal Firefighter. All eligible candidates who meet the minimum qualifications are encouraged to apply. All Seasonal Firefighters are part-time and at-will employees.

The Position:

Under general supervision, responds to fire alarms, emergency medical calls, traffic accidents, rescues, out-of-county assignments, and other emergency incidents to protect life and property. This is a seasonal firefighter position with an assignment period of up to nine months, typically from May through January. After completing a training academy, the firefighter will be assigned a shift working a 48/96 schedule, with opportunities for overtime. Seasonal firefighters will receive certified training opportunities to enhance their skills and career development. Responsibilities include participating in extensive training, hands-on drills, and independent study activities to maintain readiness and enhance skills. The position also involves assisting in the upkeep of fire apparatus, equipment, and facilities, performing various staff support tasks, and responding to out-of-county assignments as directed. Performs related duties as assigned to support the mission of the department.

Retirement:

The position is eligible for the California Public Employees' Retirement System (CalPERS), with Classic members receiving 2% 50 benefits and PEPRA members receiving 2.7% 57 benefits, with both employee and employer mandated contributions required.

Summary of Duties:

The Firefighter is responsible for combating, extinguishing, and preventing fires, as well as protecting life and property during emergencies. This role involves responding to various emergencies under hazardous and demanding conditions, which may include extreme heat, smoke, confined spaces, and strenuous physical exertion.

Firefighters provide basic life support, perform rescue and extrication operations, and assess and treat medical emergencies following established protocols. They document patient care and incident details, often working under stressful conditions that may include exposure to contagious diseases and environmental, chemical, or physical hazards.

Duties also include maintaining fire apparatus, equipment, and district property, as well as assisting with building inspections to ensure compliance with fire prevention ordinances. Firefighters follow orders from higher-ranking officers while performing their duties and are expected to exercise independent judgment and decisive action in urgent situations where direct supervision is not feasible. This position requires extensive training to perform firefighting, rescue, and emergency medical tasks effectively.

QUALIFICATIONS:

LICENSE REQUIRED

- Valid Cal-JAC Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) card to have completed by the time of appointment to the position. (Visit <https://www.fctonline.org/cpat>)
- Possession of a valid California State Driver's License, Class C.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Possession of a valid Emergency Medical Technician- B Certificate
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Professional Rescuer certification

EDUCATION

- High School Diploma or GED
- Equivalent to completion of twelfth grade.
- Additional specialized training in fire science or a related field is desirable.

Applications/Resumes will be screened for qualifications. Only the most qualified will be invited to participate in the examination process. Applications will be accepted on or before April 10, 2026, no later than 1700hrs. A resume and supporting documentation are required.

Applicants who successfully submit a complete application will receive confirmation of the testing date and time.

The top candidates from the interview process will be invited back to participate in the Chief's Interview process. The results of this interview will be used to fill current or future open positions.

Additional testing for the Firefighter position includes a background investigation and a complete pre-employment physical examination. All of these are conducted AFTER a conditional offer of employment is offered.

The district reserves the right to make changes to the announced examination process. The eligibility list generated by this process may be terminated after one year or earlier depending on district needs
